“We’re just waiting now for the soil to be turned at our new location,” said Shirley Kolompar, from the Ivy Green Residents Association. “They’re (the residents) doing fine. We know we have to move. It’s just the anticipation of when this is all going to happen.”

The residents were notified early this year they would need to move by the end of January 2010 as the owners of the park are planning a large scale development. The residents of the park sprung into action, liaising with the town and the developer to find a place for the residents to go.
